Parent(s) and Guardian(s) of ACHS students:

In order to graduate, high school students in Virginia need a minimum of 22 credits of which 6 must be verified credits (1 each in Reading, Writing, Math, Science, and History as well as one more from any core subject). Students must pass an end-of-course SOL test in addition to earning a passing grade in the course to qualify for a verified credit.

It is strongly recommended that all ACHS students participate in our after school remediation program to get additional support in academic areas in which they have needs or do not feel fully confident. Our remediation sessions will resume at ACHS on Monday, April 9th. Remediation times are from 3:00 PM until 4:30 PM, and a schedule detailing when each subject will be offered has been provided on the back of this letter. Any changes to the remediation schedule will be shared with students on the daily announcements and on the ACPS Facebook page.

For students without transportation of their own, ACPS buses will provide transportation to the following drop-off points on each Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday following remediation:

Route 1: Southern States, Winterham, Chula Junction

Route 2: Elliott's Store, Amelia Springs Express

Route 3: Truxillo Store, KB Store

Route 4: Country Quick-Stop, Sydnor Store

These sessions will provide students with additional individual attention and carefully prepared instruction that can greatly improve their comfort with, confidence in, and performance on their upcoming SOL assessments.
